I have been asked to assess the DPIA concerning the Physical Activity Pilot 2023. I have only a few comments:

- (1) Ideally, activity trackers should store their data in a sufficiently strong encrypted format.
- (2) Considering the sample size, the procedure for returning trackers to Statistics Netherlands and the nature of the data stored, I think the the associated risks are acceptable.
- (3) For the future, it would be preferable to use encryption as a risk mitigation measure.
- (4) Given the pilot nature of the research project, the use of trackers, recording movement data is necessary to attain the goal of the project.
- (5) The outcomes of the pilot will help to establish whether use of trackers for regular statistics will pass the necessity test as well.

I have no reason to advice negatively on proceeding with carrying out the envisaged data processing.
